

OUR RELIGIOUS EDUCATION



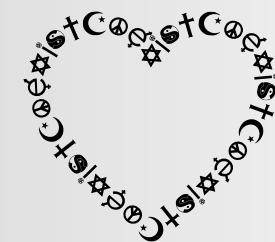
